### To improve new administration changeover process:

All CSRC Board positions should maintain a

comprehensive record of their activities to pass on to their successors.

The club bylaws shall be reviewed at least every two years and updated as necessary.

CSRC will sponsor the restart of an Interact Club at Columbus North High School CSRC will co-sponsor with the Columbus Rotary Club a Rotaract Club at IUPUC/Ivy Tech Community College
